The Saskatoon Woodturning Symposium Auction this Sunday will feature work by their incredibly talented instructors. Love contemporary, one-of-a-kind art? On Thursday, August 7 – 100 of the best pieces created at this year's Emma International Collaboration will be made available to the public.

The <u>Saskatoon Woodturning Symposium</u> is a three day event featuring critically acclaimed artist <u>Binh Pho</u>, sculptor <u>Douglas Fisher</u> and husband and wife woodturners, <u>Michael and Cynthia Gibson</u>. They and three other artists will be demonstrating at the Symposium this weekend, July 25 – 27 at Walter Murray Collegiate, Saskatoon.

The Emma International Collaboration is a weeklong residency for 100 invited international, national and provincial artists. Through hands on collaboration and exciting creative exchange, the artists explore medium, technique and push their artistic boundaries. This year Maori tattoo artist <u>Te Rangitu Netana</u>, British blacksmith <u>Adrian Legge</u> and Danish basket maker <u>Eva Seidenfaden</u> are just some of the talented international artists who are attending. July 30 – August 7 at Ness Creek Festival Site, Big River, Saskatchewan.
