Art of the Book 2013 opens at Affinity Gallery

The **Canadian Bookbinders and Book Artists** Guild (CBBAG) present this juried exhibition which marks their 30th Anniversary. CBBAG has held its Art of the Book exhibition every five years since 1988. This exhibition features 65 works and includes fine binding, calligraphy, fine printing, paper making and decorating, box making, and artists' books. There were three distinguished jurors for this exhibition. Juried by Quebec-based design bookbinder Jonathan Tremblay, private press printer and owner of Greenboathouse Press Jason Dewinetz, and Chicago design binder and book artist Karen Hanmer. The artistic merit of these pieces is high; prizes were awarded to eight entries for excellence including, Best Overall Entry.

The Canadian Bookbinders and Book Artists Guild was established in 1983 to provide contact and support for those interested in the book arts. The book arts include bookbinding, artists' books, papermaking, calligraphy, letterpress printing & typography, wood engraving, paper decorating, restoration, and conservation. http://www.cbbag.ca/home.html


